

## COVID-19 in California Quick Facts

### Face Coverings

- Until June 15, when California plans to fully reopen the economy, California will [keep its existing guidance](#) around masks in place per the [CA Health and Human Services Statement](#)
  - The state plans to allow fully vaccinated Californians to go without a mask in most indoor settings (school and office settings TBD)

### COVID-19 Employee Training

- Several U.S states require COVID-19 employee training for businesses to reopen or remain open
  - CA is one of the states and training is **REQUIRED** [per CAL/OSHA Regulations](#)
    - Topics include:
      - COVID 19 facts

      - Social Distancing
      - Hygiene
      - Health Screening
      - Job Duties

### Fully Vaccinated Individuals

- On May 3, 2021, the California Department of Public Health issued its [COVID-19 Public Health Recommendations for Fully Vaccinated People](#), which provide that fully vaccinated individuals who have had a COVID-19 exposure do not need to quarantine if they are asymptomatic
  - The San Diego County Health Order - [Quarantine of Persons Exposed to COVID 19](#) has been updated

### Reopening Resources

- Per the Safe Reopening Plan, employees are required to be screened before starting work - either self-screening or employer screening (currently still a required mandate)
- The County of San Diego's [Health Order](#) has been updated
- The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) allows small and midsize employers, and certain governmental employers, to claim a refundable tax credit
  - The IRS created a [Factsheet](#) and a [Snapshot Flyer](#) to help answer questions for employers
